

Junior Troupe Audition Package

Ages 7-11

A supportive guide for students preparing to join a more committed musical theatre ensemble.

Start with a trial class

Registration for a troupe trial class is required before auditioning. The trial class also serves as the group dance portion of the audition. After class, students stay for a brief individual song and monologue assessment with supportive coaching from the TADA team.

What to prepare

Song selection	Prepare a 30-60 second section of an age-appropriate musical theatre or Disney-style song. Choose material that feels comfortable and lets your personality come through.
Monologue	Prepare one 30-60 second, age-appropriate monologue. Select a piece you understand and can perform with clear storytelling.
Bring with you	Printed lyrics and monologue, comfortable movement clothing, grip socks or appropriate studio footwear, and a water bottle.

What happens on audition day

Students participate in the trial class first. They then remain afterwards to present their prepared song and monologue individually. The team may offer brief coaching to help students settle in and show their potential.

Troupe expectations

Troupe is a meaningful ensemble commitment. Students are expected to arrive prepared, attend rehearsals reliably, practise between classes, and support the group. Show week rehearsals, technical calls, and performances are mandatory.
